ORDINANCE LOCATING FIRE UYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana,
Illinois has recommended to the City Council that Fire Hydrants be located at
the locations hereinafter mentioned; and

Whereas, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, from the standpoint of public safety and fire protection, to have said Fire Mydrants so located.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: That Fire Hydrants be located and installed at the following locations in the areas owned by the Champaign County Housing Authority, between North Cunningham Avenue and North Broadway Avenue at the following locations, to-wit:

- In the street in front of the building designated as D-15 as shown on the building plans of said Housing Authority.
- 2. Ten feet (10°) west of a building designated as MGT, as shown on the building plans of said Housing Authority.

Such Fire Hydrants shall be installed at the above mentioned locations by the Northern Illinois Water Corporation within one hundred twenty (120) days of the date of the adoption of this ordinance, and a copy of this ordinance shall be forwarded to said Northern Illinois Water Corporation forthwith.
