## ORDINANCE TO VACATE ALLEY

136 × Pig

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the public interest will be best subserved by vacating that portion of the alley now existing between Lots 3 and 4 of Thomas Lindsey's Addition to Urbana, and Lots 3 and 4 of Block 2 of Ermentrout and Lindsey's Addition to Urbana, the same being the South Half of the alley located between Broadway and Exist Streets in the City of Urbana, and otherwise known as THORNE ALLEY;

Section 2. WHEREAS, said vacation would result in the relief to the public of further burden and responsibility of maintaining said portion of said alley between said lots, and no compensation should be due or payable by the abutting owners located on said portion of said alley so vacated;

Section 3. That said portion of said alley which lies, as aforesaid, between Lots 3 and 4 of Thomas Lindsey's Addition to Urbana, and Lots 3 and 4 of Block 2 of Ermentrout and Lindsey's Addition to Urbana, and which is the South Half of said alley located between said Broadway colouit and Market Streets, and which said alley runs from Green Street on the North end to High Street on the South end, be and the same is hereby vacated;

Section 4. The City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby releases, quit claims and conveys all the right, title and interest of said City in the East Half of said alley so vacated to the owners of the real estate abutting on said vacated portion of said alley on the East side thereof, and said City of Urbana, Illinois hereby releases, quit claims and conveys all the right, title and interest of said City in the West Half of said alley so vacated to the owners of the real estate abutting on said vacated portion of said alley on the West side thereof;

Section 5. That the vacation of said alley and said releases, quit claims and conveyances, however, are subject to existing easements for public utilities.

Section 6. Said vacation of said portion of said alley is further subject to the right of the abutting owners on said vacated portion of said alley to maintain, construct and reconstruct facilities for storm drainage and sanitary sewer in said vacated portion of said alley.
