AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AT RETAIL OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, ADOPTED MAY 17, A.D. 1954

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That an ordinance regulating the sale at retail of alcoholic liquors within the City of Urbana, Illinois, adopted by the corporate authorities of said City on the 17th day of May, 1954, be amended in reference to Section 12 of said Ordinance and Section 17 of said Ordinance, in reference to times of closing and times of the sale and offer for sale of alcoholic liquors, and in regard to the times of consumption of alcoholic liquors.

Section 12 shall be amended to provide as follows:

(Closing hours-Sundays.) It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale on the premises any alcoholic liquors in this City between the hours of twelve o'clock at midnight and six o'clock in the morning of any day, and between the hours of twelve o'clock midnight on a Saturday and six o'clock A.M. on Monday. It shall be unlawful to consume on the premises where sold any alcoholic liquors in the City between the hours of twelve-thirty o'clock A.M. and six o'clock A.M. of any day, and between the hours of twelve-thirty o'clock A.M. on a Sunday and six o'clock A.M. on a Monday. The hours to which reference is made in this Section in regard to the sale or offer for sale, or consumption of intoxicating liquors shall be based on Central Standard Time throughout the calendar year.

Section 17 shall be amended to provide as follows:

(Sale in Pool Hall.) No license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquors other than beer in a pool or billiard hall. And it shall be unlawful to sell any alcoholic liquors in a pool or billiard hall after twelve o'clock at midnight, or to consume any alcoholic liquor after twelve-thirty A.M. The hours to which reference is made in this Section in regard to the sale or offer for sale, or consumption of intoxicating liquors shall be based on Central Standard Time throughout the calendar year.
