ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.2 OF THE
ADVERTISING ORDINANCE REGARDING SIGNS
EXTENDING OVER STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That Section 3.2 of Chapter 3 of the Code of Urbana, Illinois,
be amended to read as follows:

All signs extending over a street, alley or sidewalk shall
be securely fastened and constructed of fireproof ^{material} and elevated above
the sidewalk not less than ten feet, and shall not extend more than
ten feet from the property line; in no case shall such signs project
over the paved portion of the street. Such signs shall be so maintained
and kept in repair as not to creak or make disagreeable noises.
