AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN PORTIONS
OF STREETS AND ALLEYS

WHEREAS, three-fourths of all of the aldermen of the City of Urbana, Illinois authorized by law to be elected, have determined that the public interests will be subserved by vacating certain portions of streets and alleys as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois hereby vacates the following portions of streets and alleys in the City of Urbana, Illinois, as follows:

All portions of streets and alleys lying within a subdivided area designated as Central Business ~~District~~ Addition, Urbana, Illinois, by Goodell Engineering Associates, dated June 10, 1963, and incorporated herein by reference, and not having heretofore been vacated, said plat being of an area within an area bounded by Illinois, Elm, Race and Vine Streets in Urbana, Illinois.


All of the above described property is situated in the City of Urbana, County of Champaign, State of Illinois, and the title to the land included within the certain portions of alleys and streets so vacated shall vest in the then owners of the property abutting on said portions of said alley, alleys or streets.

The City of Urbana, Illinois hereby reserves easements upon and under said portions of said alley, alleys and streets for the maintenance and repair of all sewers and drains and all public service facilities which are located on or under the surface of any part of said portion of said alley, alleys and streets, if any there be.

The vesting of title in the portions of said alley, alleys and streets shall be subject to any easement or easements for public utilities, their successors and assigns, to operate, maintain, renew and reconstruct their facilities, and


as are now operated and maintained in, over or under any portions of said alley, alleys and streets so vacated, unless the said abutting property owner should compensate the said public utilities or owners for such reasonable expense as shall be incurred by said public utilities in connection with the rearrangement, removal or relocation of said utilities, this corporate authority having determined that it is both necessary and desirable for the public interests that the public services of all of said public utilities be continued by the means of said facilities, if any are so located therein.

Adopted by the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of all aldermen authorized by law to be elected this 10th day of June, 1963.


