

AN ORDINANCE FOR LOCATION OF FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the Fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that fire hydrants be located at the following locations, and,

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrants so located, and,


WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the location of fire hydrants at the following specified locations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that fire hydrants be located in the City of Urbana, Illinois, at the following locations:

Southeast corner of Harmon and Anderson St. Lot #270  
 Southeast corner of McHenry and Anderson Lot #248  
 McHenry Street between Lots #252 and 253  
 Harmon St. and Lynn St. S.W. corner Lot #276  
 Southwest corner of Harmon and Cottage Grove Lot #281  
 Southeast corner of Scovill and Combes Lot #232  
 Northeast corner of Combes and Willard Lot #226  
 Northeast corner of Pond and Willard Lot #212  
 Southeast corner of Pond and Scovill Lot #218  
 Pond Street between Lots #177 and 178  
 Curtiss Drive between Lots #97 and 98  
 Southeast corner of Michigan and Lincolnwood Lot #120  
 Southeast corner of Michigan and Curtiss Lot #50  
 East side of Curtiss Drive at Florida Avenue

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance to the Northern Illinois Water Corporation.
