

ORDINANCE NO. 7475-30

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE  
DATE OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL FOR THE  
SECOND MEETING IN SEPTEMBER, 1974

WHEREAS, Section 2.2 of the Urbana City Code states (in part):

"The regular meetings of the city council shall be held on the first and third Mondays of each month during the year, except when such Monday shall happen to be a legal holiday, in which case the city council shall meet on the first Tuesday evening following;" and,

WHEREAS, September 16, 1974, is the third Monday in September, 1974, and

WHEREAS, September 16, 1974, is the first day of Rosh Hashana, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

1. The regular meeting of the Urbana City Council that would otherwise be held on September 16, 1974, is hereby cancelled.

2. That in lieu of the regular meeting of the Urbana City Council on the third Monday in September (September 16, 1974), the second regular meeting of the Urbana City Council in September, 1974, shall be held at 7:30 P.M. on the 18th day of September, 1974, in the City Council chambers, 400 S. Vine, Urbana, Illinois.


This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
