

ORDINANCE NO. 7677-101

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
SECTION 2.4 OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Effective May 17, 1977, for the term beginning
May 1, 1977; it shall be the duty of the city council at the
beginning of each year for which members of the city council
are elected to elect the following-named standing committees,
each committee to consist of not less than five nor more than
seven members with the first-named member of the committee being
the chairperson thereof:

- (1) Committee on environment,
- (2) Committee on public safety,
- (3) Committee on administration,
- (4) Committee on legislation,
- (5) Committee on rules.

Any appointment made prior to the effective date of
this ordinance shall terminate at the time appointments made pursuant
to this ordinance are made.

This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote,
the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the City Council
of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council
held on the 16th day of May, 1977.
