## AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT

WHEREAS, after due publication, a Public Hearing was held on the 9th day of August, 1979, concerning the Petition filed in Plan Commission Case #1074, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission recommended approval of the request that a Conditional Use Permit for a Day Care Center on the premises described below be granted:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. A conditional use permit for the use of the following described property as a Day Care Center for a maximum of 57 children is herewith granted subject to the following conditions and limitations:

- 1. That the conditional use permit would be valid only as long as the State license remained in effect and the number of children enrolled shall not exceed that permitted under the State license;
- 2. Although the parking request of one parking space for each 12 children enrolled is hereby waived, the day care center shall lease one parking space for each person employed at the day care center at the nearest available city parking lot.

All of Lot 22 of James T. Roe's 3rd Add'n as well as the South 10 feet of vacated Pine Alley lying to the North thereof together with the right to overhang the other 2 feet of the vacated Pine Alley; also the East half of vacated Church Alley lying to the West of said Lot 22, except the portion off of the east end of Lot 22 and the East end of Pine Alley dedicated when Race Street was widened.

The East 1/3rd of Lot 21 together with all of the vacated Alley lying to the North thereof; also the West Half of the vacated Church Alley to the East of Lot 21; entire intersection vacated Pine and Church Alleys.

The balance of Lot 9 at the South end after conveyance of the "North 105 ft. of said Lot 9 and the balance of the East Half of Church Alley to the West of Lot 9 after conveying out the North 105 ft. of said East Half of vacated Church Alley lying to the West of Lot 9, and all of Pine Alley South of Lot 9,

All in James T. Roe's Third Addition to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a duly called special meeting of said Council on the 13th day of August, 1979.
