

ORDINANCE NO. 8485-45

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTIONS 22-61 AND 22-65
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 22-61, entitled "Tax", of Article V, entitled "Hotel/Motel Use Tax", of Chapter 22, entitled "Taxation", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby amended by deleting and repealing subsection (e) of the said Section 22-61.

Section 2. That Section 22-65, entitled "Proceeds of tax and fines", of Article V, entitled "Hotel/Motel Use Tax", of Chapter 22, entitled "Taxation", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, any and all revenues resulting from the imposition and collection of the tax under this article, including penalties, shall be paid into the treasury of the city and shall be credited to and deposited in the corporate fund of the city.

(b) Any and all revenues resulting from the imposition and collection of the tax under this article:

(1) upon persons whose rental or leasing of a hotel or motel room in the city is in connection with participation in a convention shall be allocated to a separate fund to be known as the "Tourism Fund", which such fund is hereby created. For the purposes of this part (1) of this subsection (b), the term "convention" shall mean a meeting, conference, exhibition, or the like with respect to which a block or group of twenty (20) or more rooms are reserved or contracted for in advance of the convention by a single contracting or sponsoring entity or group, and with respect to which meeting, conference, and/or exhibition space and facilities or group meals are provided for such persons through the contracting or sponsoring entity or group by such hotel or motel. In the event a hotel or motel has insufficient rooms or facilities as required for the convention (such insufficiency herein referred to as "overflow"), the provisions of this part (1) of this subsection (b) shall apply to persons registered for such convention and who are required to find hotel or motel accommodations in a hotel or motel other than the hotel or motel where the contracting or sponsoring entity or group has made arrangements for such convention. The hotel or motel providing such rooms, including the overflow rooms, shall maintain adequate and sufficient

records to evidence such revenues resulting solely from the imposition of the tax under this article by such persons in connection with such participation in a convention; and

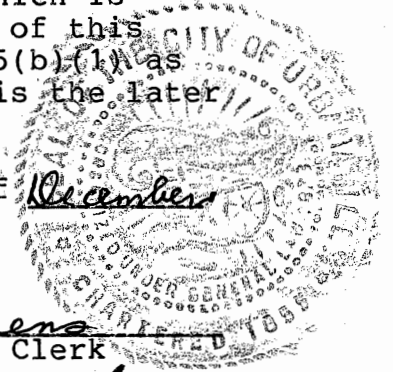
(2) over and above the base amount in any fiscal year of the city shall also be allocated to the "Tourism Fund". For the purposes of this part (2) of this subsection (b), the amount of \$130,000, which such amount represents the total amount of revenues budgeted and anticipated to be collected by the city from the tax imposed under this article for the fiscal year 1984-85, is hereby determined to be the base amount.

Any such amounts so collected by the city and so allocated to the "Tourism Fund" shall be expended by the city in such manner as is approved by the City Council in the Annual Budget Ordinance solely to promote tourism and conventions within the City or otherwise to attract nonresident overnight visitors to the City.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as required by law, or after the passage, approval and publication as required by law of an ordinance duly passed and adopted by the City of Champaign, Champaign County, Illinois, which is substantially similar to the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance and the amended provisions of Section 22-65(b)(1) as contained in Section 2 of this Ordinance, whichever is the later date.

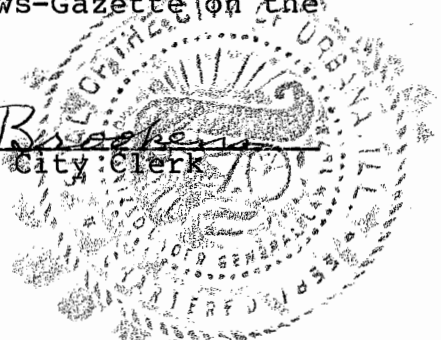

ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN, ILLINOIS, WHICH SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO THE amount in any fiscal year of the "Tourism Fund". For the purposes of this part (2) of this subsection (b), the amount of \$130,000, which such amount represents the total amount of revenues budgeted and anticipated to be collected by the city from the tax imposed under this article for the fiscal year 1984-85, is hereby determined to be the base amount.

Any such amounts so collected by the city and so allocated to the "Tourism Fund" shall be expended by the city in such manner as is approved by the City Council in the Annual Budget Ordinance solely to promote tourism and conveniences within the City or otherwise to attract nonresident overnight visitors to the City.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as required by law, or after the passage, approval and publication as required by law of an ordinance duly passed and adopted by the City of Champaign, Champaign County, Illinois, which is substantially similar to the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance in the amended provisions of Section 22-65(b) (1) as contained in Section 2 of this Ordinance, whichever is the later date.

read as follows:

(a) Except as provided in subsec-
tion (b) of this section, any and all
revenues resulting from the
imposition and collection of the
tax under this article, including
penalties, shall be paid into the
treasury of the city and shall be
credited to and deposited in the
corporate fund of the city.

(b) Any and all revenues resulting
from the imposition and collection
of the tax under this article:

(1) upon persons whose rental
or leasing of a hotel or motel room
in the city is in connection with
participation in a convention shall
be allocated to a separate fund to
be known as the "Tourism Fund",
which such fund is hereby created.
For the purposes of this part (1) of
this subsection (b), the term "con-
