ORDINANCE NO.9596-105

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE (Section 14-13, Section 14-4 and Schedules M, N, K)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The following sections and Schedules of the Urbana Local Traffic Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) Section 14-13:

- "§ 14-13. Parking time limited on certain streets or public parking lots.
- (A) When signs are erected in each block or in each municipal parking lot giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period of time in excess of that indicated upon said sign at any time between the hours indicated upon said sign on any of the streets or public parking lots described in Schedule N attached to and made a part of this Traffic Code. Schedule N shall set forth the maximum time limits for such areas respectively.
- (B) Each police officer or parking meter patrol person or assistant shall place securely in a conspicuous location on every vehicle parking in violation of any of the provisions of this section a notice that such vehicle has been so illegally parked and instruct the operator as to the procedure of paying any fine therefor or of contesting the violation.
- (C) Any person who permits a vehicle to be parked longer than the period of time indicated on said sign as provided in subsection A of this section may, within twenty-four (24) hours of the time when the notice required in subsection B of this section was placed upon such vehicle, pay as the penalty for, and in full satisfaction of such violation, sums as indicated in the Schedule of Fees and fines adopted pursuant to Section 14-7 of the Urbana City Code. The failure of such person to make such payment within such seventy-two (72) hours shall render such person subject to the penalties provided in Article XVI of this Traffic Code."

(b) Section 14-4:

"§ 14-4. Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets.

When signs are erected in each block or in each municipal parking lot giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified in Schedule K of any day within the District or on any day specified upon any of the streets described in said Schedule K attached hereto and made a part of this Traffic Code. Schedule K shall set forth the maximum time limits for such areas respectively."

(c) Schedule N:

"SCHEDULE N

Parking Time Limits Pursuant to § 14-13

Three Hour Parking 8AM to 9PM Except Sundays and City Holidays

Section 2. That portion of Schedule M relating to Tow-Away Zone, 3AM to 9:30AM is amended to read as follows:

"Tow-Away Zone, 3AM - 9:30AM

Rows AS1 through AS6 of Municipal Parking Lot 10A South and Lot 10A North."

Section 3. Schedule K is amended in the following manner:

(a) The first paragraph thereof is amended to read as follows:

"In accordance with Section 14-4, and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified herein on any day within the district or upon any of the streets or parts of streets or in any municipal parking lot as follows:"

^{*}References to Municipal Parking lots are made in accordance with official map bearing designations of such prepared by and kept by the Comptroller of the City of Urbana.

(b) Add to Schedule K the following new paragraph:

"No parking 3:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.:

Rows AS1 through AS6 of Municipal Parking Lot 10A South and Lot 10A North."

<u>Section 4.</u> All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
