## RESOLUTION CONCERNING FIRE PROTECTION IN AREAS NOT WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA.

ILLINOIS that commencing on the 1st day of February. A. D. 1956. the

Urbana Fire Department shall not make any runs to fight fires outside of
the corporate limits of the City of Urbana. Illinois except as follows:

- l. Fire protection may be extended to commercial establishments located within the area which is two (2) miles South, three (3) miles East and three (3) miles North of the intersection of Main Street and Vine Street in the City of Urbana, paying a minimum charge of Fifty Dollars (\$50,00) or 12 per cent of the assessed valuation of said commercial establishment, whichever is greater, and has contracted in writing to pay the City an additional amount in case an actual run is made to protect said property, of .04 per cent of said assessed valuation, and a sum equal to Five Dollars (\$5,00) per mile per truck traveling to and from said property. It shall not be mandatory for the City to furnish such fire protection but such protection shall be furnished at the discretion of the Chief of the Fire Department.
- 2. When a petition for annexation has been filed in the County
  Court of Champaign County. Illinois for the purpose of annexing a contiguous
  territory to the City of Urbana and when a copy of the notice of the County
  Court hearing for such annexation proceeding has been filed with the Chief
  of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, then fire protection shall be
  rendered to properties within the area described in said petition until
  such time as the said area has been annexed to said City, or until the
  petition for such annexation has been adjudicated to be legally insufficient.
- 3. Fire protection may be continued to churches, schools, hospitals and other governmental, charitable or educational buildings located within the above described area on payment to the City of One Hundred Dollars (\$100,00) annually in advance, and on agreement to pay an additional sum equal to Five Dollars (\$5,00) per mile per truck traveling to and from said property in event of fire. This fire protection shall also be at the discretion of the Chief of the Fire Department. The Fire

agreements made with the University of Illinois, the City of Champaign and other cities and governmental agencies offering reciprocal protection.
