

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has adopted by reference and is enforcing the City of Urbana's Zoning Ordinance; the National Building Code, 1967 Edition with Appendices A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, N, O and P; the Illinois State Plumbing Code, 1969 Edition, with amendments; and the National Electrical Code, 1970 Edition; and

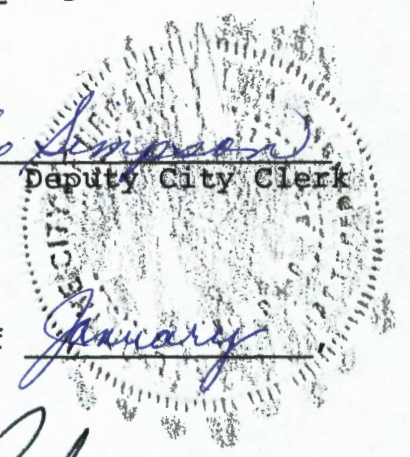
WHEREAS, the Building Official is responsible for having all plans and specifications for proposed construction and remodeling examined and reviewed for compliance with City Codes prior to issuing a building permit.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL that the Building Official, or his authorized agent, shall review all building permit applications for new construction and other improvements requiring permits (as building, plumbing, electrical, etc.) to determine whether the building site will be substantially safe from flooding. If a site, on which there is proposed a new building or addition, or remodeling, is a location that has a flood hazard, the proposed construction and/or improvements (including prefabricated or mobile homes) must be designed or modified to prevent flotation, collapse, or lateral movement of the structure, use construction materials and utility equipment (including but not limited to plumbing, heating and electrical equipment) that are resistant to flood damage and use construction methods and practices that will minimize flood damage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby appoints and authorizes the Building Official with the overall responsibility, authority and means to implement all commitments made herein.
