

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING RESOURCE
RECOVERY PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND FEASIBILITY STUDY

WHEREAS, the Cities of Champaign and Urbana have jointly operated a common solid waste disposal facility since July 1, 1976, under the authority of the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the citizens of Urbana to support resource recovery and to seek inter-governmental assistance for the engineering study to determine its feasibility; and

WHEREAS, the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System is authorized to apply for and receive federal assistance to finance resource recovery project development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System be and is hereby encouraged and supported in its effort to obtain financial assistance to defray the cost of engineering studies to determine the feasibility of resource recovery in the Champaign-Urbana area.

2. That the City of Urbana will give strong consideration to providing whatever long-term commitments that may be found appropriate for a municipal resource recovery system.
